

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

Support native and organic Ecuador products: cacao balls, beans, and nibs, and coffee harvested and processed by proudly organic FOCAZNOM farming families and their displaced families: Muñoz in Agua Fria, Parraga in Palma Sola, Delgado in La Kalada, Moreira in Remojo, and Figueroa in Tabuchila. These products have been harvested and prepared in an ecologically responsible manner by small local farmers for a premium value to fundraise and provide incomes for people who have lost their homes and livelihoods.

As the Federation of Rural Communities in the Northern Manabí Area, farmers, fishermen, and artisans from 34 different communities have worked together since 2000 to improve their lives and society. For each pound and ball purchased, \$1 will go towards long term FOCAZNOM projects which create jobs, empower farmers and displaced families, promote organic farming, coordinate the childcare programs in this area, and recover Manabita customs and culture. Direct donations are always welcome and appreciated.



\$14.50 per pound of roasted Arabica coffee* ground or whole bean

\$4 per pure native cacao ball, 100g*

Dissolve pieces in milk or water and combine with other ingredients (sugar, cinnamon, allspice, etc.) to make chocolate sauce, chocolate milk, and other desserts just as you would with baking chocolate.

\$5 per pound of "raw" cacao beans*

\$12 per pound of roasted and peeled cacao beans and nibs*

Use as a topping or start from the raw material to make your own balls , chocolate covered beans, and more cacao creations!
